**NOTIFICATION**

**Whereas**, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an Institution of higher learning as deemed to be University.


2. **And whereas**, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, vide its Notification No. 9-27/2000-U.3 dated 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2004, on the advice of UGC, had declared Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh) as an Institution Deemed to be University under De-Novo Category under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 subject to a review after three years. The functioning of the Deemed to be University was subsequently reviewed by the UGC. Further, on the advice of UGC, the Central Government, vide its Notification No.9-27/2000-U.3 dated 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2008, extended the Deemed to be University status of Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh) for another period of five years i.e. from 01.11.2007 to 31.10.2012.

3. **And further whereas**, the UGC constituted an Expert Committee to examine the performance and academic outcomes of the Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh). The Committee, in its report, gave the **good** grade to Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh) on academic performance of the Institution and recommended for continuation of their Deemed to be University status. The report of the UGC Committee was considered by the Commission in its 544<sup>th</sup> meeting (Item No.2.12) held on 16.10.2019 in which the following resolution was passed:

*"The Commission, considered the report of the UGC Expert Standing Committee and resolved to continue/extend Deemed to be University status for those Institutions who were rated Excellent, Very Good & Good for academic performance by the Expert Committee. However, those Deemed to be Universities which were rated poor and average for academic performance will not be granted continuation / extension."*

4. **Now, therefore**, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of UGC, hereby extends the Deemed to be University status of Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh) from 01.11.2012 onwards.


5. The all other conditions mentioned in the earlier Notification(s) of this Ministry as well as the Rules / Regulations of UGC and other Statutory Councils, issued from time to time, shall continue to be adhered by Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh).

NOTIFICATION

Whereas "Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT)", Noida (Uttar Pradesh), was declared as a 'deemed-to-be-university', under *De Novo* category' under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 vide this Ministry's notification of even number dated the 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2004 subject to certain conditions that included a review after three years;


2. And whereas, the UGC has reviewed the functioning of the "JIIT", Noida through an Expert Committee constituted for this purpose;

3. And, whereas, on the basis of the report of the Expert Committee, the UGC vide its communication No.F.6-8/2004 (CPP-I) dated the 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2008 have recommended continuation of the status of 'Deemed-to-be-University' to "JIIT", Noida, subject to a further review after five years;

4. Now, therefore, the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, and on the advice of the UGC in the matter, do hereby accord approval to the continuance of "Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida, as a "deemed-to-be-university" for the purpose of the aforesaid Act, under *de novo* category, for a further period of five years, strictly in terms of this Ministry's notification of even number dated the 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2004, subject to the following conditions that:

- (i) the progress and performance of the JIIT shall be reviewed by the UGC with the help of an Expert Committee after a period of five years and that the status of 'deemed-to-be-university' conferred on the JIIT, Noida, shall be confirmed on the basis of the report of the said Expert Review Committee and recommendation of the UGC thereon;
  - (ii) the JIIT should immediately revise the Memorandum of Association (MoA) / Rules in line and in accordance with the model MoA/Rules prescribed by the UGC and get the approved MoA/Rules duly registered;
  - (iii) the JIIT Society should, as per the advice of the UGC, submit an undertaking, on stamp paper, from the Jaiprakash Sewa Sansthan (JSS) Trust, New Delhi that the land subleased by the NOIDA will be allowed to be in possession of JIIT, Noida, permanently; and,
  - (iv) the JIIT should adhere to the norms and guidelines prescribed by the UGC and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), from time to time, as are applicable to the institutions declared as deemed-to-be-universities under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956.
5. The declaration made in para 4 above shall be subject to further conditions that are mentioned at Sl. No. 4 of the endorsement of this notification.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the University Grants Commission, hereby declare the Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida (Uttar Pradesh) as Deemed to be University under De-novo category for the purpose of the aforesaid Act with immediate effect subject to review after three years.

The grant of de-novo Deemed to be University status to Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, Noida is subject to the conditions that (i) JIIT, Noida will revise/ amend its MOA/ Rules as per UGC Model MOA / Rules for deemed Universities; (ii) JIIT, Noida will get its land transferred in the name of JIIT Society; and (iii) It will adhere to the guidelines / instructions issued by UGC and AICTE from time to time as applicable to the Deemed Universities".
